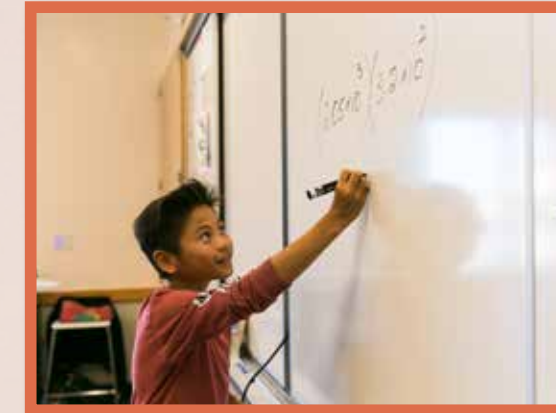
## Needed Repairs to Help Students and Teachers Focus
